For training purposes, the strongest backbone is: one systematic Lukas textbook, the three Lukas/Schönfeld clinical companions, and a focused Frankl core including *The Doctor and the Soul*, *The Will to Meaning*, *Yes to Life*, and *Man's Search for Meaning*. *Meaningful Living* and *Man's Search for Ultimate Meaning* substantially round out practice and later Frankl thought.
